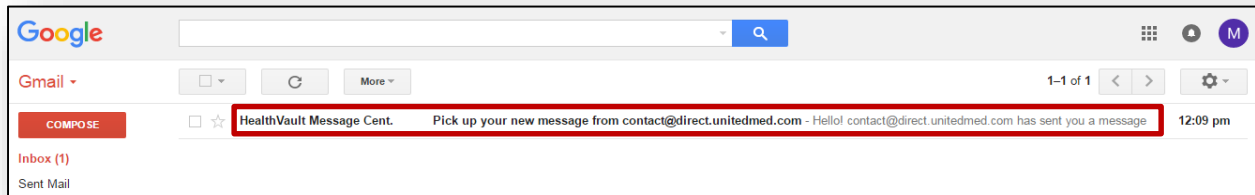

BHMG – United Medical uses Microsoft® HealthVault™ as our secure patient portal to let you view, download, or print your health information anytime!

Getting Started

Whenever you visit your doctor at BHMG-United Medical, you will receive an email from [HealthVault Message Center \(hsmailer@healthvault.com\)](mailto:hsmailer@healthvault.com) to pick up your new message from contact@direct.unitedmed.com. *Note: You will only receive these emails if you have chosen to opt-in to receive emails during your registration process at BHMG-United Medical.*



This email serves as notification that new health information is available for your HealthVault account. The email itself **DOES NOT contain any sensitive, medical, or personal information.**

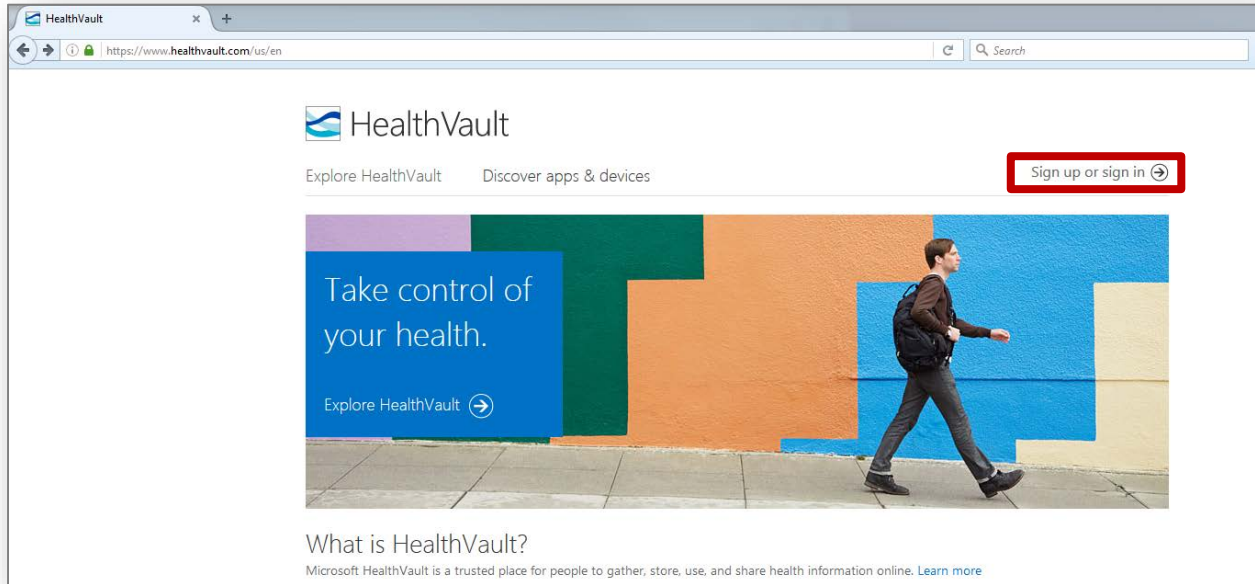

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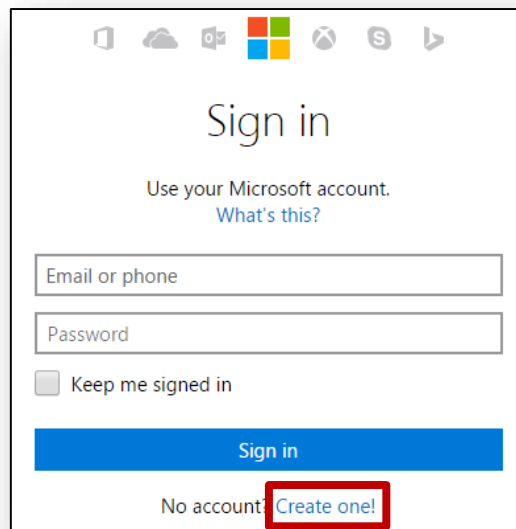
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To Create An Account From HealthVault.com

Open your browser and type 'https://www.healthvault.com/us/en' in the URL and click on [Sign up or sign in](#).

For example, if your birthday is on January 1, 1954, your answer would be: 01/01/1954. ***For security purposes, HealthVault will not let you proceed if your birth date does not match the birth date on record with BHMG – United Medical.*** Click **Continue** to proceed.
